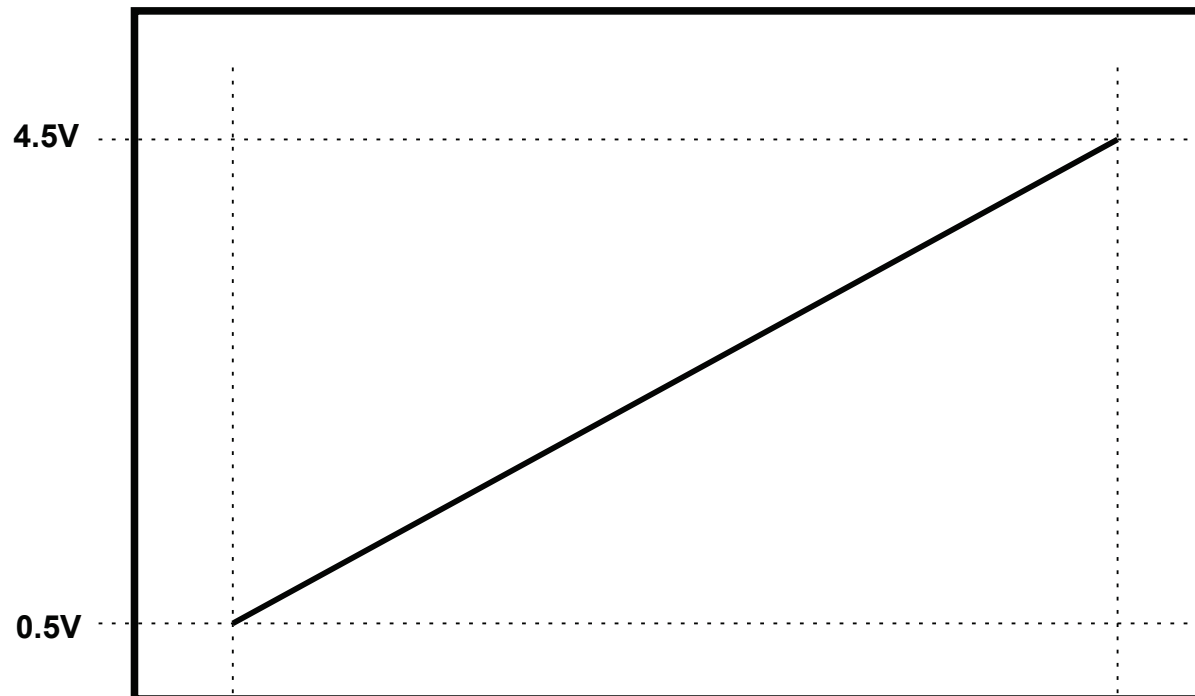




Pressure Vs Voltage



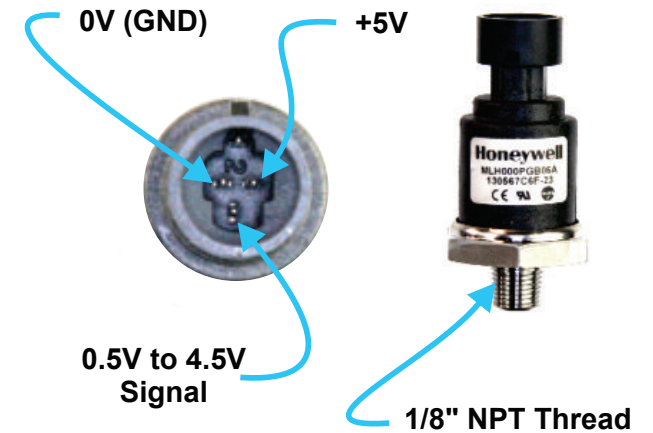
0PSI Gauge
(Atmospheric Pressure)

100PSI Gauge
(100PSI Above Atmospheric
Pressure)

NOTES:

Gauge Pressure is pressure above atmospheric pressure. You might also think of it as "positive" pressure".

This is an active sensor. Do not use a pull-up resistor on the signal of this sensor. The output is driven to the correct voltage by the electronics inside the sensor.



APPLICATIONS:

This sensor is most often used to monitor fuel and oil pressure.

This sensor has a stainless steel body.
